The Marble Route: Vila Viçosa & Borba. Soak up the gleaming splendor of Alentejo's marble towns, where the local white marble adorns façades, fountains, benches and doorways. Enjoy guided strolls through both towns, and tour the majestic, marble-clad Ducal Palace in Vila Viçosa.

Winery Vila Santa. Savor outstanding wines and lunch at a beautiful winery.

Évora. In Alentejo's capital city, take in Roman ruins, Moorish-influenced buildings, and handsome palaces and noble houses from its pinnacle as a royal city. Visit the Chapel of Bones, an unusual, 16th-century monument built by Franciscan monks.

Monsaraz. Relish the medieval ambience of this picturesque, hilltop village with great views of the rolling countryside. Travel next to Herdade do Esporão to taste delicious olive oils and enjoy a relaxing lunch with wine on this large estate. Stop later in São Pedro do Corval, known for its traditional pottery workshops. Visit a pottery studio and watch artisans craft colorful pieces.

Mérida. Journey into Spain to see Mérida's superb ruins that reflect the glory of the Roman Empire. Appreciate the classical lines of the elegant theater and stand in the amphitheater where gladiators battled.

Olivenza, Bridge of Cultures. Meander in one of Spain's prettiest villages, which was part of Portugal until 1801. See the blend of cultures revealed along its lanes and view artifacts at a museum inside a 13th-century castle and 18th-century bakery.

Elvas. This border town once protected the key crossing between Madrid and Lisbon, and its 17th-century fortifications feature a thick wall with jutting bulwarks to defend from any angle. On a guided walk, learn about its strategic importance and delight in inviting squares like the Praça da República.

Lisbon. Revel in vibrant Lisbon on a scenic tour/guided walk. Go inside the magnificent Jerónimos Monastery to see the exquisite church and cloisters ornamented in the Manueline style, and marvel at the imposing Tower of Belém over the Tagus River. Later tonight, enjoy a moving *fado* performance.
