#### A World of Discovery

Afro-Cuban Havana. Join writer/activist Roberto Zurbano as he shares secrets of Old Havana on a walking tour. Stop at Beyond Roots, an independent shop that highlights Afro-Cuban culture, and meet the store's founder. Continue to Regla, known for its storied traditions of Santería, Palo Monte and Afro-Cuban religions, and see the Church of Our Lady Regla. Visit Guanabacoa, the center of Havana's Afro-Cuban culture, for an intimate cultural experience with a Babalawo priest.

Vibrant Havana. Stroll along Callejón de Hamel, an alleyway with Santería statues, temples and murals, and experience their Sunday's Afro-Cuban performance. Next, an expert leads a thought-provoking tour that showcases Afro-Cuban art in Havana's National Museum of Fine Arts. Then, climb into one of Cuba's vintage convertibles for a memorable ride along the Malecón, Havana's evocative sea drive, followed by a visit to the historic Hotel Nacional.

Cuban Arts & Culture. Be welcomed to the Sephardic Hebrew Center and gain insight into Havana's Jewish community. Visit local dance company Malpaso to watch dancers rehearse and speak to them about their profession, dreams and expectations in Cuba. Later, gather on a terrace overlooking Havana to meet Wilfredo Benítez Munőz, Executive Director of the philanthropic Ludwig Foundation. Learn how it promotes contemporary Cuban artists and culture.

Matanzas. Travel to Cuba's epicenter of Afro-Cuban culture, where many slaves were brought from Africa. Here, visit with African cultural and artistic community groups and individuals with influences throughout the province. Hear a performance by a small chamber orchestra, Camerata Jose White. After lunch, visit the Sugar Mill Triunvirato to see the moving, Monument to the Slaves' Rebellion.

#### Norma Guillard & Cuban Dance.

Meet Norma Guillard, a Cuban social psychologist and adjunct lecturer at the University of Havana and learn about her work with the Cuban Literacy Campaign. Visit women-owned shops in Old Havana that are re-purposing old paper goods and recycled leather scraps into products. Talk to female entrepreneurs about their experience and enjoy lunch at a female-owned cafe.

Rural Cuba. Enjoy the views of tobacco and sugarcane fields as you travel to visit Las Terrazas, a model socialist community, to learn about their conservation efforts. Also, visit and talk with the principal at a local school, stop at an artist's studio, and savor lunch of locally grown vegetables.
