A World of Discovery

Old Havana. In Habana Vieja, the historic heart of Havana, take a street-by-street tour of the four main plazas of Old Havana. Chat with vendors, and bargain for Cuban memorabilia, in turn, supporting their families. Visit Dador, an independently owned clothing store founded by three Cuban women to learn about the hardships and rewards of owning a Cuban business. Also, visit the historic Hotel Nacional.

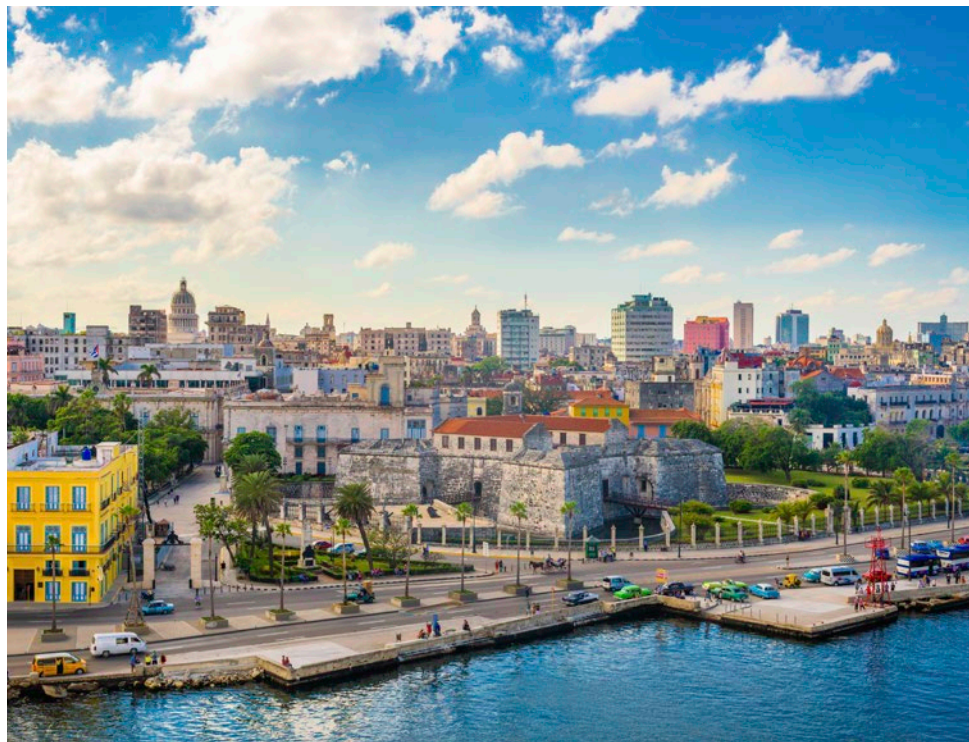
Scenic Convertible Ride. Experience a special excursion in a privately owned, vintage convertible as you drive along the Malecón, Havana's evocative sea drive, and talk with your friendly, local driver.

Cuban Art & Culture. Meet with Wilfredo Benítez Munõz, Executive Director of the Ludwig Foundation's gallery at Havana's National Museum of Fine Arts to learn about the museum's collection and the Foundation's efforts to promote contemporary Cuban artists and culture. Visit Casa Fuster, the home and studio of Cuban painter and sculptor Jose Fuster. Travel to Cojimar to visit *Finca Vigía*, the storied home of author Ernest Hemingway.

Matanzas. Travel to Cuba's cultural hidden gem rarely visited by tourists. Stop at Puente de Bacunayagua, the longest and highest bridge across Cuba, with stunning views over a wooded canyon of the lush Yumuri Valley. Tour Matanzas to glimpse life outside the capital. Pass by the Sauto Theatre and the historical French quarter. Stroll around the city center through Libertad Park and visit a 19th-century French-style pharmacy founded by Ernesto Triolet in 1882. Enjoy a performance by a local choir and chat with choir members.

Social Issues & Cuban Dance. Meet Norma Guillard, a Cuban social psychologist and adjunct lecturer at the University of Havana. Listen to her stories about working with the Cuban Literacy Campaign and her work with women in low-income areas. Be welcomed to the Sephardic Hebrew Center and gain insight into Havana's Jewish community. Visit the Casa de la Cultura to discover its purpose and interact with staff and children performers. Learn about Afro-Cuban dance from local dancers who teach tango and salsa. Also visit local dance company Malpaso to speak to the dancers about their profession, dreams and expectations in Cuba, and to see them rehearse.

Rural Cuba. Take a scenic drive through the countryside to visit Las Terrazas, a model socialist community. Walk through the town, visit an artist's studio and a local school, and have a farm-to-table lunch.
