A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | Les Pastras. Meet the Franco-American owners and tour the olive tree grove to see how olives are harvested and made into oil. Learn about cultivating and finding black truffles and then join professional hunters in the search for France's elusive "black gold." Savor a tasting of fresh truffle appetizers, various oils and Champagne followed by a Provençal buffet lunch in this picturesque setting.

Aix-en-Provence & Cézanne's Atelier.

On today's guided tour, stroll upon the Cours Mirabeau, considered one of the most beautiful boulevards in Europe. Then, immerse yourself in the artist's life with a Cézanne studio tour. Travel on to the sun-drenched fishing village of Cassis on the Mediterranean coast for a fresh seafood lunch before taking a scenic cruise through the deep, narrow inlets of the Calanques.

Avignon & the Pont du Gard. In Avignon, explore the impressive Palais des Papes—a fortress-like medieval masterpiece with ramparts, towers and turrets—which sits on the banks of the Rhône River. After lunch, travel to the site of Pont du Gard, the enormous aqueduct built by the Romans in 19 B.C. and an ancient engineering feat.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Visit the historic wine making village in the idyllic countryside of southeastern France's Rhône Valley. Relish a winery tour and delicious tasting of the powerful, full-bodied red wine.

Arles, Les Baux-de-Provence and Saint-Rémy-de-Provence.

Journey to Arles for a guided tour to see the ancient amphitheater of Les Arènes and the 12th-century Cathédral Saint-Trophime, a masterpiece of Romanesque style. In the hill town of Les Baux, experience medieval life with its tiny squares and cobblestone streets. Travel to nearby Saint-Rémy to see the lush green, perfumed valleys that inspired Vincent Van Gogh's paintings.

Marseille. Discover France's oldest city, founded around 600 B.C. by Greek settlers from Phocaea. Today, Marseille is a dazzling metropolis on the Mediterranean. On a guided coach and walking tour, see the Palais Longchamp, admire the magnificent view from Notre Dame de la Garde, and take a stroll through Le Panier, the oldest district of Marseille. Enjoy lunch and explore Marseille further at leisure this afternoon.

Lourmarin & Cucuron. Relish a panoramic tour of two of the most enchanting villages in the Luberon massif. Lourmarin was once home to Nobel Prize-winning author Albert Camus and expatriate author Peter Mayle. Then, learn to play Provence's most popular pastime, the competitive game of *pétanque*!
