Day 1 | In Transit

Depart gateway city for Zürich, Switzerland.

Day 2 | Zürich, Switzerland | St. Moritz

Upon arrival, transfer **3** to St. Moritz and check in to the hotel.

Join us for a Welcome Reception tonight.

Day 3 | St. Moritz

Enrichment: *Essential Switzerland.* An expert shares the unique elements of Swiss culture.

St. Moritz Walking Tour. Enjoy a walking tour in the famous mountainous resort of St. Moritz. Admire jaw-dropping Alpine vistas and glimpse daily life at local shops.

Free Time: Enjoy leisure time this afternoon.

Day 4 | St. Moritz

Free Time: Soak up the pleasures of St. Moritz at your own pace. Take a slow stroll by the lake, tackle a nearby trail on an active hike or share a bottle of wine at a sidewalk café.

Day 5 | Bernina Express | Tirano, Italy | Zuoz, Switzerland | St. Moritz

Bernina Express Train. Wind your way from craggy mountain peaks to palm-lined streets during a train ride to Tirano, Italy. The Bernina Express, one of Europe's most impressively engineered rail routes, traverses magnificent

mountain passes, sweet villages and valleys. Get to know Tirano on a walking tour and enjoy lunch before continuing to Zuoz by coach.

Zuoz Walking Tour. Explore this endearing Upper Engadine village on a guided tour. Stroll along the charming streets of Zuoz and view the beautiful cobblestone main square, bubbling fountains and colorful 13th century buildings.

Day 6 | Lake Como, Italy | Bellagio | Stresa

begin your journey to the shores of Stresa, Italy. The Road to Stresa. See sparkling glacial lakes and meadows, punctuated by Swiss villages, along the dramatic landscapes of the Maloja Pass. Your drive takes you through breathtaking scenery and across the border into Italy. Arrive at Tremezzo and board a boat to cross over to Bellagio. It's easy to see why poets and writers from around the world have found inspiration in Bellagio. With its inviting sun-splashed squares

to the quaint cobblestone streets bordered by cream and peach façades, we think you will also find inspiration in the "Pearl of the Lake!" Following lunch, enjoy a scenic private cruise to the town of Como, gliding by a shoreline brimming with colorful flower gardens, famous villas and forests. Disembark in Como and continue to Stresa via motor coach.

Check in to the hotel and gather for a delicious Italian dinner this evening.

Day 7 | Borromean Islands

Enrichment: *Italy's Lake District.* Discover how this region became a favorite retreat.

The Borromean Islands. These famous islands are located in the turquoise waters of Lake Maggiore and are named after the Borromeo family who has owned them since the 15th century. Cruise aboard a private motorboat to Isola Madre, the largest of

the Borromean Islands. Enjoy a guided visit to the island's English-style gardens filled with flowers, rare plants and ancient trees. You may also spot a variety of peacocks, parrots and pheasants! Travel on to discover the sweet, quiet charms of Isola dei Pescatori; then cruise to Isola Bella, the "Beautiful Island." Explore a palatial baroque palace and summerhouse that is home to a mosaic grotto and an astounding collection of antiques and art from the Borromeo family's private collection. Cap off the excursion with a relaxing walk through the island's terraced hanging gardens.

Enrichment: Golden Age of the Renaissance. Join an expert to learn about the true genius of Michelangelo and Leonardo da Vinci.

Day 8 | Milan

Exploring Milan. Venture beyond Stresa to Italy's economic powerhouse. Visit Milan's Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie to witness da Vinci's "The Last Supper." This masterpiece, one of the artist's greatest paintings, is painted on the wall of a dining hall in the monastery's





refectory. Next, discover the world of opera at La Scala Museum where Puccini's "Madama Butterfly" and Verdi's "Otello" were first performed. See the Duomo, Milan's most famous building. This symbol of the city dominates the Piazza del Duomo.

Free Time: Craft your own path through Milan. Explore shops in the fashion district or take in views from the roof of the Duomo.

Day 9 | Stresa

AHI Connects | The Piedmontese

Kitchen. Journey through the hills to visit a family-owned restaurant. Join an expert chef to learn how to prepare a variety of traditional Piedmontese dishes. This authentic cuisine is based on using locally grown produce and ingredients. Tuck into a tasty lunch, complemented by sprawling lake views.

Free Time: Spend your final afternoon relaxing by the lake or sip an apéritif with friends. Tonight, celebrate the end of a wonderful journey at a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Day 10 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer \Im to the Milan airport for the return flight \Im to your gateway city.
