### Day 1 | Miami, Florida | Lima, Peru

Depart Miami for Lima, Peru. Upon arrival, transfer to the Pullman Lima Miraflores.

### Day 2 | Lima

**Highlights of Lima.** View the Larco Museum's excellent collection of pottery and artifacts that spans more than 5,000 years of pre-Columbian Peruvian history. Continue to Plaza Mayor, lined with stately, colonial-era buildings, in Lima's historic center. After a guided stroll, stop for lunch at Pardos Chicken, a popular Peruvian restaurant. Later, see the splendid interior of the Cathedral of Lima and visit the beautiful Monastery of Santo Domingo with relics of important Peruvian saints. Next, step inside Casa Aliaga, a delightful gem built in 1535 and still occupied by descendants of the Aliaga family. Admire its grand rooms richly adorned in wood and the serene courtyard.

**AHI Connects |** *Meet the People.* Tonight, enjoy a Welcome Reception and Dinner at Casa Garcia Alvarado, a National Historical Building. Tour this elegant, private home and savor a traditional meal with one of the owners.

### Day 3 | Lima | Cusco | Sacred Valley

Check out of the hotel after breakfast and transfer to the airport for your flight to Cusco. Upon arrival, take a panoramic drive to the stunning Urubamba Valley, the Sacred Valley of the Incas, amid towering mountain slopes. Check in to the Casa Andina Premium Valle Sagrado and dine on Andean cuisine tonight.

### Day 4 | Sacred Valley

**Sacred Valley.** Explore Ollantaytambo, an Inca hillside fortress renowned for its huge terraces.

Monastery of Santo Domingo, Lima

Then, delve into the Incas' agricultural practices at the circular Moray Terraces, created as an experimental farm in the 15th century. Travel next to a mountain village to learn about ancient weaving methods and life in this challenging environment. Conclude with a wonderful lunch at a family estate that boasts lovely grounds, gorgeous views and fine artwork.

### Day 5 | Sacred Valley | Machu Picchu

Take in scenic views on a train ride through the Sacred Valley to the town of Aguas Calientes and the Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo hotel.

Machu Picchu. Nestled in a cloud forest high in the Andes, the Lost City of the Incas is regarded as the most important archaeological site in the Americas. The mountaintop complex contains more than 200 buildings, all of which testify to the Incas' remarkable architectural skills. Wander through the temples, palaces and grassy plazas with your expert guide.

### Day 6 | Machu Picchu | Cusco

**Free Time:** Your morning is at leisure. Relish picturesque mountain scenery on your

return train ride, then depart by motor coach for Cusco and check in to the Palacio del Inka.

Free Time: Make your own plans for dinner.

### Day 7 | Cusco

**Cusco, Ancient Inca Capital.** Set 11,152 feet above sea level, Cusco was the religious and administrative center of the Inca Empire. Enjoy guided visits to the Cathedral on the Plaza de Armas, noted for its colonial art, and the Santo Domingo Church, built on the foundations of the Incas' Koricancha Temple dedicated to the worship of the sun.

Take a break for a delicious lunch nearby.

**Sacsayhuaman**. Marvel at the immense stones (one weighs 125 tons!) of this imposing lnca fortress constructed without any mortar.

### Day 8 | Cusco | Lima | Iquitos | Nauta | Cruising

This morning, transfer to Cusco's airport for your flight to lquitos via Lima. Make your way through lquitos, the gateway to the Amazon and accessible only by plane or boat, to Nauta on the Marañon River. On your route, see the vibrant *terra firma* (non-flooded forest). Embark the Delfin III at a private port in Nauta. As your cruise begins, soak up sweeping views from

the observation deck while your naturalist guide reviews upcoming activities and the wildlife and plants that you are likely to see.

### Day 9 | Cruising the Amazon Basin

Set out aboard skiff boats, anticipating the day's astounding and unexpected wildlife encounters. Pacaya Samiria National Reserve, where the ship cruises, is one of Peru's largest wildlife preserves with more than five million acres of rich biodiversity. Marvel at grey and pink dolphins and watch for toucans, macaws and capybaras hiding in the rain forest as you skim along rivers, creeks and lagoons.





### Day 10 | Cruising the Amazon Basin

Rising early is always rewarding since wildlife is most active at daybreak. Hike with your expert guide into the rain forest to discover the fantastic flora and fauna, including colorful parrots, hummingbirds and "laughing" falcons. Sharp eyes may spot red howler monkeys, sloths, butterflies and tarantulas. You'll also have the chance to fish for piranhas!

### Enrichment: Contemporary Peru.

Gather for a Farewell Reception on the ship.

### Day 11 | Nauta | Iquitos | Lima | Miami, Florida

After breakfast, disembark the ship in Nauta and transfer by coach to the Iquitos airport.

Manatee Rescue Center. On your route, stop to see these endangered creatures up close. Fly to Lima and connect to your return flight to Miami, Florida.
